The program cost is \$50 per person and includes an overnight stay at the HI-LA South Bay Hostel, the Bridging Ceremony for Girl Scouts program, Discover Angel's Gate Park hostelling activity, snacks on Saturday afternoon, Saturday night dinner & dessert, Sunday breakfast and the Girl Scouts Go Hostelling Patch. Bring a sack lunch for Saturday afternoon and a towel for showering ~ *sheets, blankets & pillows are provided as part of your overnight. For hygiene purposes, sleeping bags are not allowed.* To reserve space for your troop a \$25 non-refundable deposit for each person attending the Girl Scout Weekend is required. Full payment is due 30 days prior to each program. Bridging Ceremony Weekends are open to Brownie, Junior, Cadette, Senior, and Ambassador level scouts. Leaders must attend with your troop. Each weekend program requires a minimum of 20 and a maximum of 50 participants collectively. Register early so we can coordinate program plans based on our scouting levels.
